

Custodial Efforts for Pandemic Circumstances

Disinfectant products for use; Vindicator, Oxivir TB, Disinfectant wipes or Bleach Water (1/3 cup bleach to a gallon of water)

DAILY: By Custodial Staff

- Regular /Routine cleaning using current Custodial Procedures Manual cleaning and disinfecting products and procedures.
- After cleaning an area, with **Suprox**, disinfect all door knobs, crash bars, table tops, desk tops and handrails with **Vindicator , Oxivir TB, disinfectant wipes or Bleach Solution (1/3 cup bleach to a gallon of water)** using a spray bottle, backpack sprayer or Clorox 360 system.
- As per the Custodial Procedures Manual, restrooms will be thoroughly cleaned in the evenings by spraying all fixtures (sinks, toilets, urinals) with pre-mixed **Vindicator** and allow dwelling for 10 minutes to ensure proper disinfection. During the school day, the restrooms will be disinfected twice daily using **Oxivir TB** to disinfect restroom surfaces.
- Mid-day disinfecting of door knobs, crash bars, table tops and handrails using **Vindicator, Oxivir TB, Clorox wipes or Bleach Solution (1/3 cup bleach to a gallon of water)**.
- Ionization Machines-spraying disinfectant on hard surfaces daily to cover large areas in a short period of time. (Depending on the product, most products require 1 minute to 10 minutes that the product stays wet on a surface to be effective)
- Oxivir TB RTU, (requires no PPE); kills in one minute; after one minute, it can be wiped off or left to dry. Product breaks down to H₂O and O₂; This will be used in restrooms and high touch areas multiple times per day.

These systems speed up the process by which custodial staff can apply disinfectant and sanitization processes; therefore increasing the number of times per day that it can be applied.

DAILY after each lunch mod: By cafeteria aides, assigned teachers or support staff, or custodians

Cafeteria tables will be cleaned with soap and water and then a spray (Oxivir TB RTU; requires no PPE; see above) will be applied. Can be left to dry or wiped with a cloth or paper towels.
