School nurses at Bellefonte Area School District have been approved to participate in the Fluency School Health Program through Kinsa, which allows families of elementary children who attend the district to receive a free smart thermometer.

The mission is to prevent the spread of illnesses in school, which has a positive ripple effect to learning.

According to Kinsa, they have opened a "Text-to-Join the Waitlist" campaign for the parents at our schools. Then, when the thermometer order window officially opens in early September, parents on the waitlist will receive a text invitation to download the Kinsa app and officially sign up for a free smart thermometer!
