WHEREAS, the Bellefonte Area School District Board of School Directors recognizes the importance of an educational environment where every person can fully and comfortably be themselves regardless of age, race, gender, ethnicity, intellectual or physical disability, sexual orientation or identity, religion, socio-economic standing, or other dimensions of identity.

- To support and collaborate in the work of the district's Inclusion, Diversity and Equity (IDE) Committee.
- To provide educational training and professional development opportunities focusing on inclusion, diversity and equity for faculty, staff, students, the Board of School Directors and the community.

- To support and collaborate in district initiatives on inclusion, diversity and equity that involve working with other public or private schools, governmental agencies or entities, and community or professional organizations.
- To support the administration and staff's efforts to develop and implement a historically and culturally accurate curriculum that is equitable to all students, regardless of race, gender, ethnicity, intellectual or physical disability, sexual orientation or identity, religion and socio-economic standing.
- To provide equitable access to co-curricular and extracurricular activities, enrichment opportunities and social services, regardless of race, gender, ethnicity, intellectual or physical disability, sexual orientation or identity, religion and socioeconomic standing.
