FUNDRAISER PICKUP:

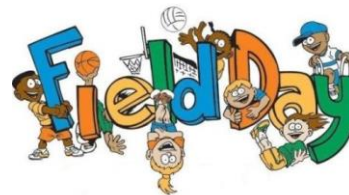
