Location

The Bellefonte Area School District is located in Centre County, Pennsylvania and is at the geographical center of the state. The Pennsylvania State University's main campus is only ten miles away. Interstates 80 and 99 provide easy access to the community.

Community

The Bellefonte area is rich in history. The political, industrial, and educational areas have always been important in the development of the town. Centre County was created in 1800 and Bellefonte became its county seat. The claim "home of seven governors" is an example of its political influence. The limestone industry remains a staple of the local economy. The surrounding mines produce one of the highest grades of limestone in the world. The schools in Bellefonte joined with the schools in the surrounding townships in 1953 to form the Bellefonte Area School District.

GPA is computed according to this scale. A weighting factor of 1.07 is applied to Advanced Placement courses and a weighting factor of 1.04 is applied to Honors courses. Class rank is computed at the end of every school year. Weighted class rank is reported to colleges unless an un-weighted rank is requested.

AP Exams: BASD was placed on the College Board's 9th Annual AP® District Honor Roll for Significant Gains in Student Access and Success. During the 2021-2022 school year, 88 students took 129 Advanced Placement exams, 74% of those 129 exams received a score of 3, 4, or 5.
